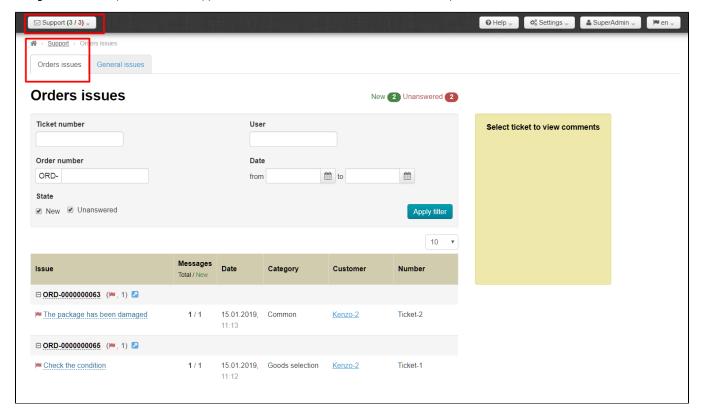

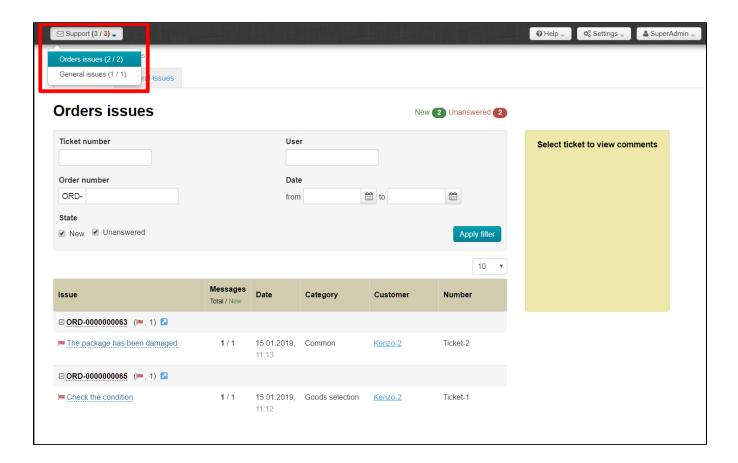

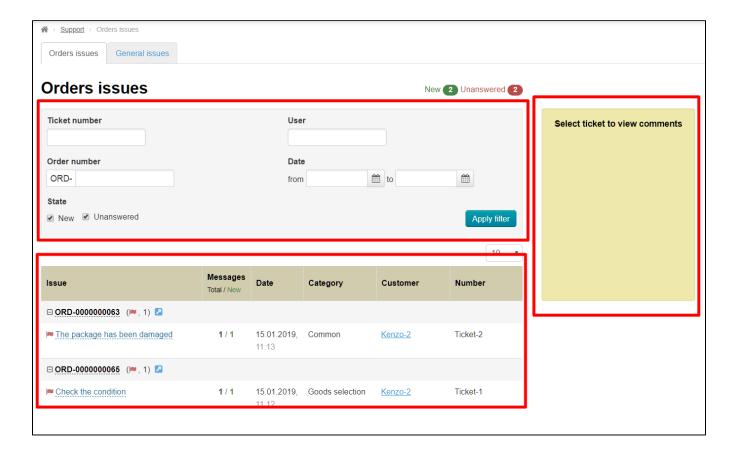
Description

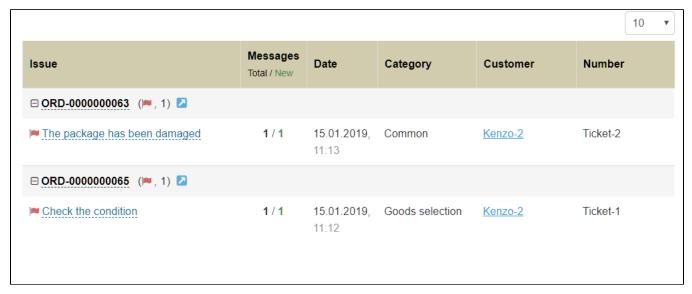
"Working with issues" section consists of three blocks: filters, a list of tickets and comments for tickets.

A table of tickets lists the following data:

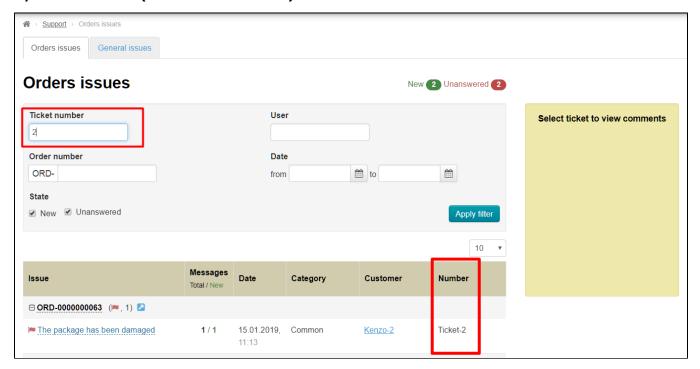
- Subject

- Issue number



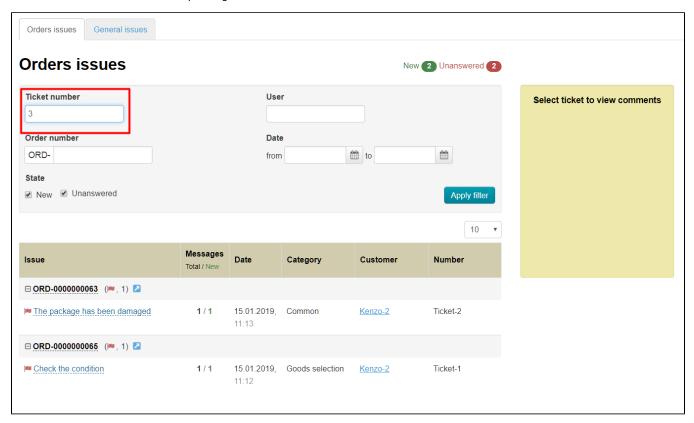

There are several ways to find necessary ticket.

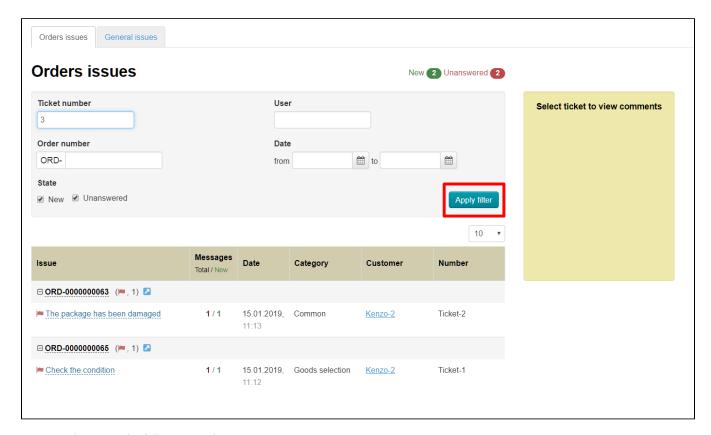

Click appropriate issuesubject if you want to read an issue.

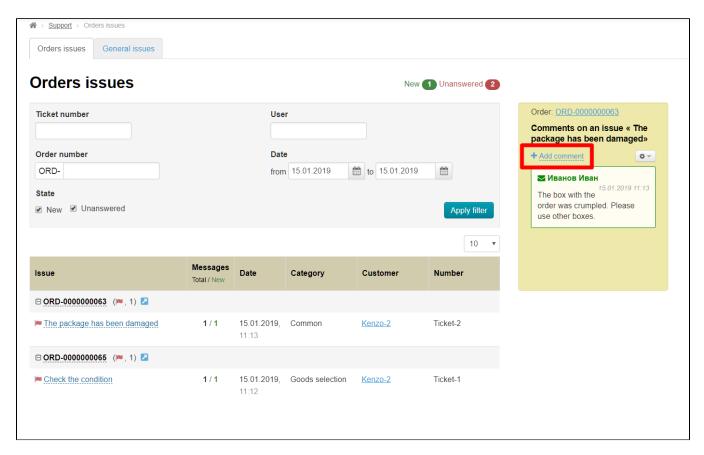

Once you do that, a reply will appear both in admin area and in Customer's personal account.

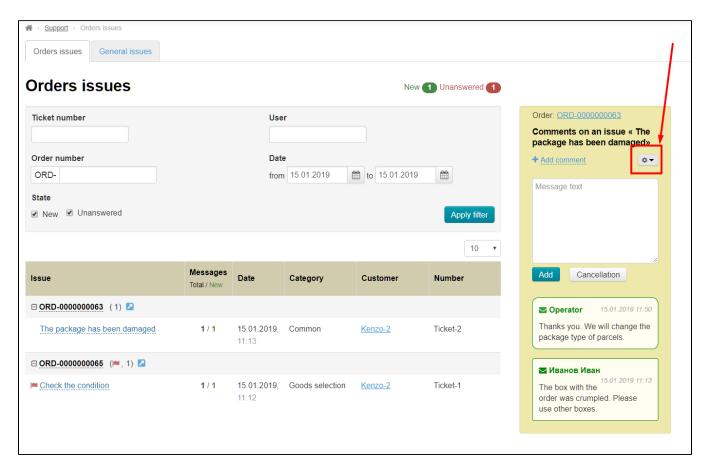




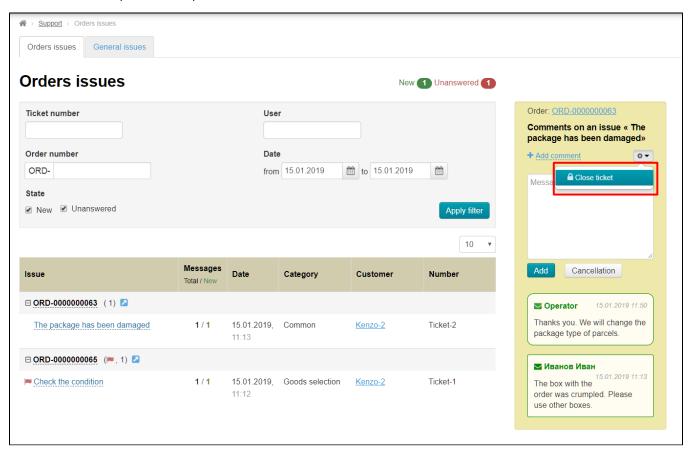


Close an issue

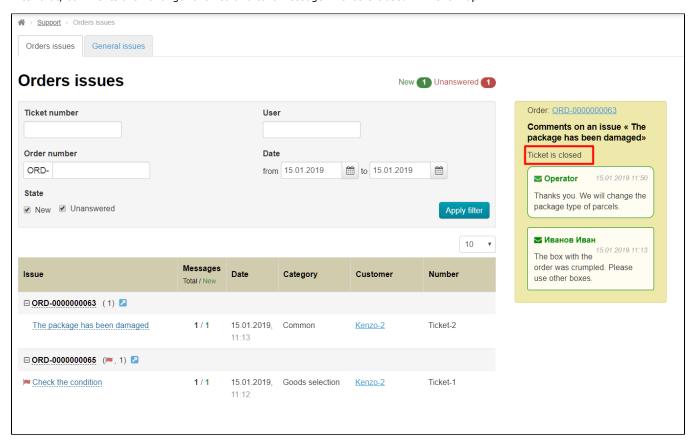
Click gear button.
